Read every day. Watch informative programs in Discovery channel, National Geographic channel etc. Revise the concepts taught in class.

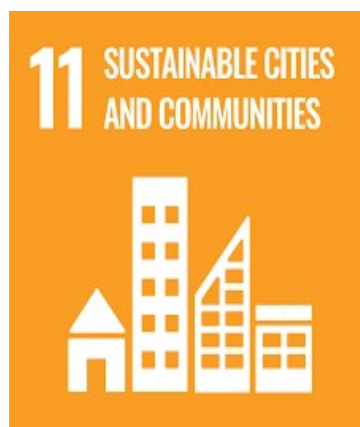


# SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS
