Example:

You: Hello, Computer! What do you do all day?

Computer: I work, play music, and help people do homework!

Type it or write and decorate it by hand on A4 size sheet.

4. App Explorer Journal

Pick any 2 apps or websites you use (e.g., YouTube Kids, Google, MS Paint).

Write a few lines about:

- **What it does**
- **What you like about it**
- **One thing you learned from it**

Decorate it with the app's icon/logo.

5. My Robot Buddy (Draw & Describe)

Imagine you have a robot friend!

Draw it and write 5-6 lines about:

- **Its name**
- **What it can do**
- **How it helps you**

6. Learn with YouTube

Watch any child-friendly computer basics video (e.g., parts of a computer, how the internet works).

Write 3 things you learned and draw a small picture about one.

7. My Keyboard Song (Creative Writing)

Write a funny rhyme or song about the keyboard or mouse.

For example:

“Click-click goes the mouse,

Zoom-zoom through the house...”
