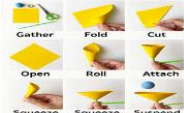

Grow Your Own Plant - Students will plant a seed (bean/mustard) in a small pot or cup. They will water it daily and observe growth for a week.  Design Your Magic Lamp – Students will make and decorate a magic lamp using clay and tell their one wish.  Draw Your Bedtime Scene - Students draw a picture of their bedtime routine (brushing teeth, reading, sleeping, etc.).  Collective Noun Nature Craft - Students create a big collage scene On one sheet divided into 3 parts: Sky/Tree Area – Draw a nest with birds Write: “<i>A flock of birds</i>” Water Area – Draw fish in water Write: “<i>A shoal of fish</i>” Land/Farm Area – Draw cows in a field Write: “<i>A herd of cows</i>”  Tense Time Wheel - Students make a rotating wheel with three parts: Past (Yesterday), Present (Today), Future (Tomorrow). Then they will write one sentence in each section. 

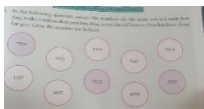
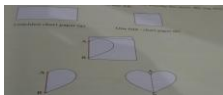
