"Never Give Up, Stay Focused, Stay Positive...and LET YOUR LIGHT SHINE"

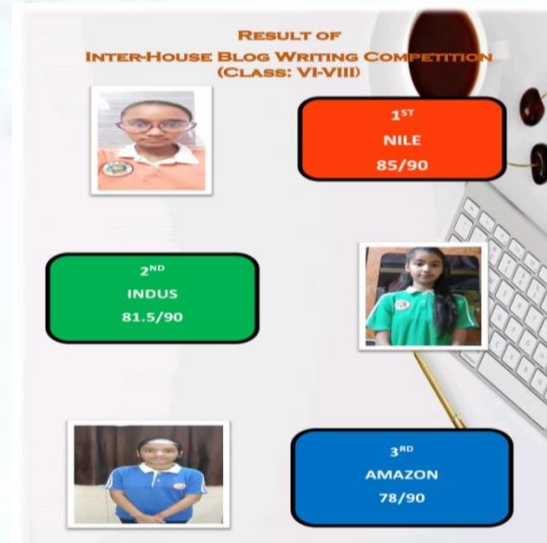
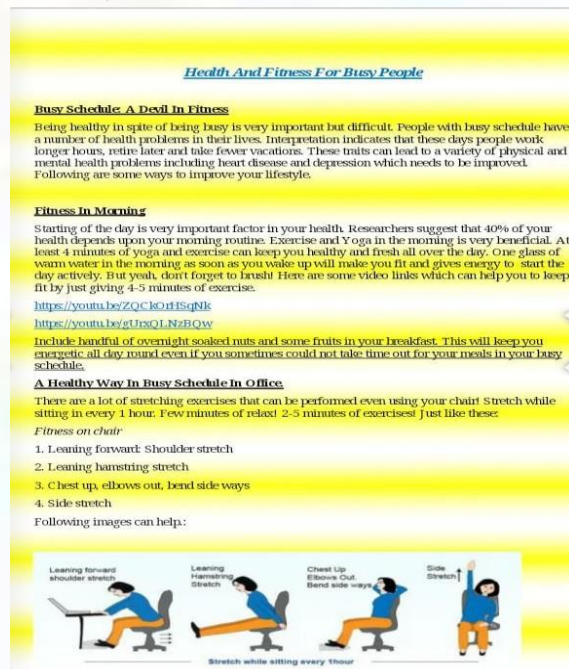

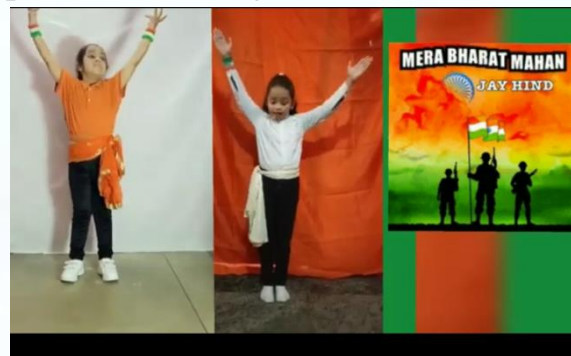
Storytelling Through Yoga
