Read every day. Watch informative programs in Discovery channel, National Geographic channel etc. Revise the concepts taught in class.

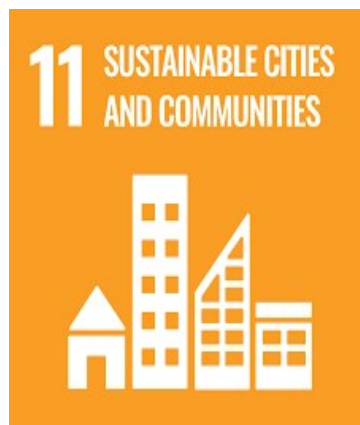


SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS

INTEGRATED PROJECT WORK

Prepare two flyers on the topic: "Sustainable Cities Flyers".

The flyer should focus on sustainable urban development and for spreading awareness about the importance of building resilient and inclusive cities and communities.

I. Content should be in English and Hindi language.

II. Steps to be followed for preparation of flyer:

1. Research on SDG 11: Understand what SDG 11 is about. It focuses on making cities and human settlements inclusive, safe, resilient, and sustainable.
2. Identify key points: Highlight key aspects of SDG 11, such as affordable housing, sustainable transport, green spaces, and resilient infrastructure.
3. Design layout: Choose a layout that is visually appealing and easy to read. Include the SDG 11 logo or symbol.
4. Use compelling visuals: Show the comparative data on the bar graph. Incorporate images or graphics that represent urban sustainability, such as green cities, efficient public transportation, or community engagement. Make a beautiful political map of our country.
5. Craft clear message: Write concise and persuasive text that explains the importance of SDG 11 and how individuals or communities can contribute to its achievement.
6. Review and revise: Double-check for errors and ensure all information is accurate and up-to-date before finalizing the flyer.

III. Use a digital tool like Google or Canva etc.:

For "Green Spaces" - add images of parks, gardens, and green roofs.

For "Renewable Energy"-- add images of solar panels, wind turbines, and hydroelectric power.

For "Eco-Friendly Transportation" - add images of bicycles, electric vehicles, and public transportation.

For "Reduce, Reuse, Recycle" - add images of recycling symbols, composting, and waste management.

For "Community First" - add images of people from diverse backgrounds living together in harmony.

For "My Pledge" - add a personal message or drawing of how you plan to contribute.
